Acceptable Use Policy Agreement

It is the responsibility of each organization and district to communicate to parents and students the following criteria in its district's technology acceptable use policy.

What do we collect?

Presto Assistant stores information such as:

- Name
- Email
- Date of Birth
- Gender
- Phone Number
- Address
- Grade
- Student ID

Who do we collect data from?

This data is entered by up to four parties:

- Teachers
- Parents
- Students
- Parent volunteers with proper permissions

How do we use this information?

This information is used for Presto Assistant to work as intended. It will be visible to your students' fine arts teachers, district administrators, and any parents in the organization with permission to view student details (such as parent volunteers). This data allows a teacher to have quick access to contact information.

Do we share your information?

Presto Assistant stores this data using only the services necessary. We do not share your information outside of the services we use. These services include:

- AWS and Heroku (database)
- Firebase (database for audit logs)
- Sendgrid (email sender)
- Stripe (online payment processing)

Do we sell your information?

Absolutely not. Never have, never will.

How do we protect your information?

Presto Assistant uses modern, industry-standard technologies to ensure your protection. Access to these technologies is limited only to the Presto Assistant employees who help manage these services. User passwords in the database are hashed (one-way encryption), so any employees with access to that data will not be able to view or decrypt your password.
